General Boat Description

The 2013 Back Cove 34 is a popular Downeast-style cruiser known for its classic aesthetics, single-engine efficiency, and comfortable, well-appointed interior. This model is highly regarded for its blend of classic style, practical design, comfortable amenities, and reliable performance, making it a popular choice for coastal cruising and overnighting.

Key Features and Design:

- **Downeast Heritage:** True to the Back Cove brand, the 34 embodies the timeless Downeast design, characterized by a spooned bow, gentle sheer line, and a reverse transom. This gives it a classic, elegant look.
- **Single-Engine Power:** The 2013 Back Cove 34 is typically powered by a single Cummins QSB 6.7L 480-horsepower diesel engine with direct drive. This configuration is favored for its fuel efficiency, ease of maintenance, and lower operating costs compared to twin-engine setups.
- **Construction:** Back Cove boats are built with quality in mind. The hull is often vacuum-bagged and PVC-cored, with solid fiberglass stringers co-infused for a robust, one-piece structure. Decks are cored with balsa for strength and weight savings.
- **Helm Deck and Galley:** The helm deck offers a semi-enclosed bridge deck with a full galley to starboard and a dinette to port that can comfortably seat four adults and often converts to an additional berth. Two drawer-style refrigerators are typically found under the helm seats. The helm often features a comfortable Stidd seat and a comprehensive electronics package (often Garmin).
- **Accommodations Below Deck:**
 - **Master Stateroom:** Forward, you'll typically find a comfortable island queen berth with drawers and storage below.
 - **L-Settee:** To port, an L-shaped settee with an inlaid teak table converts to a second berth, providing flexible sleeping arrangements for up to four people in the cabin.

Privacy can be provided by a curtain.

- **Head:** A standout feature on the 34 is the spacious head to starboard, which includes a separate stall shower – a highly appreciated amenity on a boat of this size.
- **Headroom:** The cabin generally boasts generous headroom, around 6'6".
- **Finish:** The interior is typically finished with varnished cherry joinery, premium hardware, and a durable synthetic teak and holly sole.
- **Cockpit:** The cockpit features an L-shaped bench seat and a fold-away aft-facing seat, offering comfortable lounging space. Engine access is excellent, with the entire helm deck lifting hydraulically to expose the mechanical systems.
- **Maneuverability:** While a single-engine boat, the 34 commonly includes bow and stern thrusters, which significantly enhance maneuverability and ease of docking.
- **Amenities:** Common features include air conditioning (often with multiple units, including the cockpit), a Kohler generator, an inverter system for off-grid power, electric windlass, hot and cold cockpit shower, and a swim platform with a ladder.
